


Red Rock Lake Herbicide Treatment May 2023



RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. See map for treatment area locations.

The treatment size is limited by MnDNR permit requirements. Surveys identify areas of highest CLP density for treatment location(s).

After treatment, the MnDNR recommends <u>not using</u> the water for these activities for these number of days:



Swimming 1 day



Drinking 3 days



Irrigation 7 days

RPBCWD will work with a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control Curlyleaf Pondweed in the lake. *The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.*

What: Herbicide treatment (Aquathol)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake (see map on front)

Why: To control Curlyleaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant

When: Week of May 15th, if weather allows. Delays/rescheduling
