

Data Request

The Minnesota Government Data Practices Act (Minn. Stat. § 13) is a state law that controls how government data are collected, created, stored, used, and released. The law establishes requirements relating to the right of the public to access government data and the rights of individuals who are subjects of government data. Access to government data is defined in Minn. Stat. § 13.03.

You may be required to pay for the costs of searching for and retrieving government data, including the cost of employee time, and for making, certifying, and electronically transmitting copies of public data.
